"I suggest attending Design Miami/ with interesting lectures and commissions that are a must-see. Pérez Art Museum: Miami today is home to the largest art fair in the United States—it made no sense at all not to have a respected museum in this city. After a multimillion-dollar investment, a couple of years ago the Pérez Museum opened its doors with world-renowned exhibitions, cutting-edge architecture, and a pretty decent café inside. Worth the visit."

"South Pointe Park: A peaceful, gorgeous, recently renovated and clean park at the tip of South Beach. Good for anyone looking for an authentic Miami experience that doesn't necessarily involve sand or a pool. Also a great spot for sunsets. Two is the "100+ Degrees in the Shade" show, an exhausting survey of Miami artists. Three is "The Machine Show" at the enigmatic Swampspace, where the cafecitos are blacker than night and more bitter than hell. Oh, and I almost forgot, my show at Fred Snitzer's will be out of this world..."

#HAPPYHOUR

"Joe's Stone Crab: A classic. It's the Peter Luger of Miami, but instead of steak you get giant crab legs. It is difficult to get a reservation during that week, but well worth the effort! Casa Tua Restaurant: For a fantastic Mediterranean meal, sitting in the garden at Casa Tua is heaven, totally transporting. Versailles Cuban Restaurant in Coral Gables: Crazy over-the-top and great Cuban food."

#BESTINMIAMI

"111 Lincoln Road Parking Garage by Herzog & de Meuron: I love the work of Herzog & de Meuron and would definitely recommend checking out the parking garage they designed on Lincoln. Vizcaya Museum & Gardens: My first job out of college was as an assistant to a fashion stylist, and we often made trips down to Miami to shoot at Vizcaya. I'm assuming the various fashion companies wanted a location that felt like Europe but was a close flight to New York. It's quite amazing. You feel so far away from Miami—not a piece of contemporary art or furniture in sight!"

"Design Miami/ Basel Miami: As much as Art Basel Miami is about art, it is also about design. I love to visit Design Miami/ Basel to look at both contemporary and classic modern design."

"For a very late night out, try Twist on Washington Street."

"Bodega is one of my favorite happy hour/ munch spots in South Beach. Chef Bernie Matz has created a modern take on Mexican that goes perfectly with his extensive tequila menu. No trip to South Beach is complete without spending time with uber-mixologist Albert Trummer at The Drawing Room. Meg Sharpe's interior brought back the cool Rat Pack vibe that Morris Lapidus originally envisioned for Shelborne."

#BESTINMIAMI

"For something offbeat, visit the so-called "Museum of the Streets," Wynwood Walls, and see the world's greatest artists working in the graffiti and street art genre. Jeffrey Deitch co-curated the first successful year of the project, cementing its place in cultural history. Also, I recommend a visit to the PAMM, designed by Pritzker Prize-winning architects Herzog & de Meuron. Awe-inspiring "Shower Curtains" by Oscar Muñoz welcome you on arrival from a distance."

#TOPARTSPOT

"Rosa de la Cruz Collection is very unique, with artist- and docent-led tours of one of the world's most import art collections. Rosa's personal eye makes this contemporary art space a masterpiece in itself. Don't be surprised if you see her leading a tour with top artists in tow!"

"Most travelers spend a lot of time by the pool or beach, but locals are usually cruising around on their boats. Visiting Miami's great lunch spots by boat or going to the keys with friends is a completely different experience. It's chic, laid-back, and plugs you right into nature."

"Sweet Liberty: The best oysters in town, shuffleboard, and of course the Elyx copper Owl Signature serve the "What What." Edition Hotel: This sexy property boasts my favorite bowling alley and ice-skating rink. And when I'm done falling on my face I head over to their disco-themed nightclub Basement. GKB: Want to drink off the beach? Head to GKB and try the Sahumerio with Absolut Elyx, starfruit, orange, Darjeeling, and chamomile. Did I mention it has scented dry ice with it? Setai: If you're feeling like luxury, swing by the Setai for the Elyx Copper Pineapple. Did someone say caviar and cigar menu?"

"Miami City Ballet: Celebrating their 30th year with performances of George Balanchine's Swan Lake, Liam Scarlett's Viscera, and Jerome Robbins's Fancy Free. (You can sip on a Elyx cocktail if you happen to make it to the Behind the Bar performances.)"

"Avant Gallery: If you like contemporary art like Alec Monopoly, then make sure you check out this gallery. Their distinctive style always disrupts in the most delicious manner. They showcase Alexey Wind, DAIN, and Metis Atash, to name a few of my favorites. Make sure you check out Wynwood Walls, especially Miami Native Nicole Salgar and her famous Flamingo."

#MYMIAMITREAT

"During Basel most people stay on the beach, so my Miami Treat would be to pop over to Brickell for a dinner and a show at El Tucán. The show boasts acts like Grammy Award-winning Marlow Rosado and his full band. Dancing shoes: Check."
